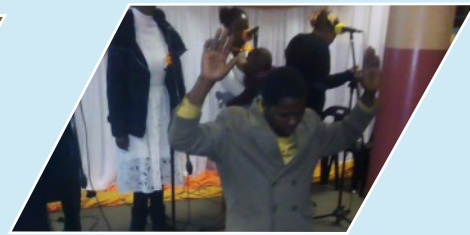

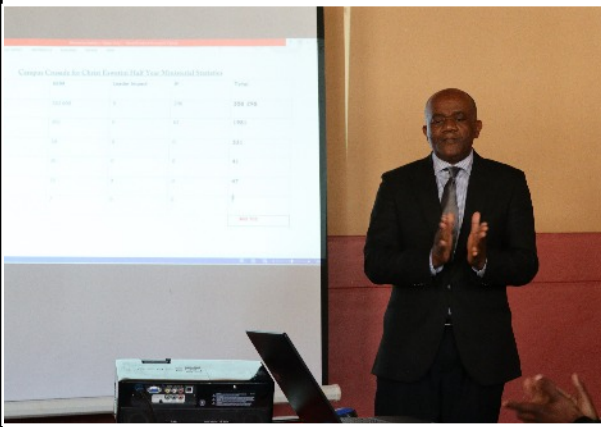

ESWATINI LEADERSHIP VISIT KENYA FOR TMPD ORIENTATION

On the first week of July 2022, the Eswatini Campus Crusade for Christ leadership team left the country to attend the first in line of Sustainability workshops.

The intention of the trip was to expose the Eswatini leadership team to the Kenyan ministry, which is more advanced, to learn from the experience and to implement. Another intent was to strengthen the partnership between the two countries.

The Eswatini team was toured around and was exposed to different ministries, departments and offices of the Kenyan entity, by the leadership and staff from Kenya. Much was learnt from the in depth details of operations, and processes in these different areas.

After the tour, the Eswatini team had an intensive training on various ministry areas which included among others, Sustainability, and Fund Development. In the discussions, much was learnt on how to raise, lift, maintain, and multiply partners.

Speaking about the trip, the Eswatini National Team Leader was quoted as saying, "The main intent of the trip was to expose my team to the Kenyan ministry, which is more advanced and ahead of us, to learn from, and to come back and implement most in the country also."

He went on to thank the Kenyan team for the overwhelming reception and meeting opportunity.

"I believe this has enriched my team and it is going to long lasting fruits, again thank you so much to the Kenyan team for their hospitality and commitment to helping our ministry", he said.

The partnership between Kenya and Eswatini was sealed by this trip and more collaborations were agreed upon especially through online trainings. Kenya promised to include Team Eswatini in their Sustainability workshop for staff, which later happened (*See Page 10*)

INTOXICATED MAN RECEIVES CHRIST FROM GCM ALL NIGHT PRAYER

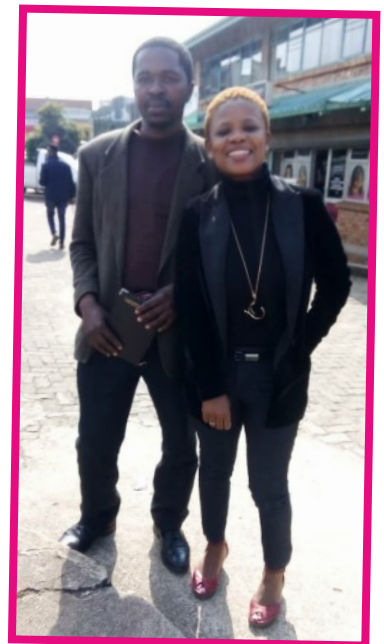


An intoxicated man got born again from attending the CCC Womens' All Night Prayer.

MRS. DLUDLU RETIRES FROM CCC ESWATINI

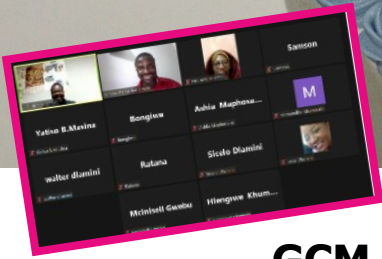

The 10 week MC2 training consisted of CCC Eswatini new staff members, associate staffs, and volunteers.

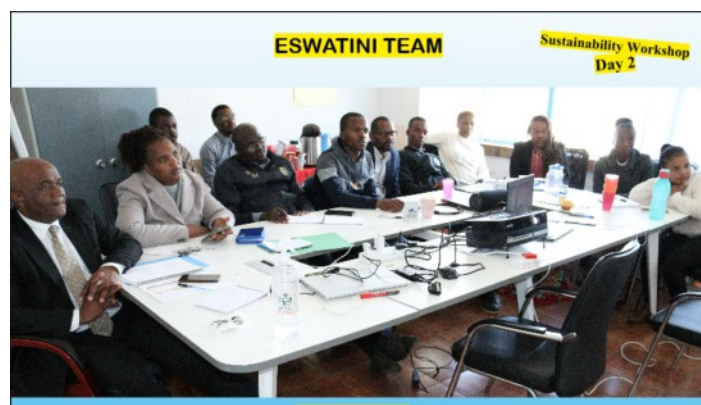
Concluding the training, NTL Rev. Samson Nzima thanked everyone for their vigorous dedication throughout the 10 weeks, and urged everyone to

but not limited to; the 5 every's, sustainability significance, Sustainability cycle, T-MPD Training process, Fund Development as a ministry, and Leadership Commitments.

Though crippled by technical and sound issues at times, the online workshop was very fruitful as it also helped the local team to strategize for their next projects and ways in which they will raise to see them succeed.

MC2 PARTICIPANT STARTS SPORTS MINISTRY & A NEW CHURCH

If you would visit Embikwakhe sportsground on an evening week-day, you would find a warm welcoming 'Coach' Walter training young footballers between the ages 8 and 16.

About 50 aspiring footballers attend these sessions which are always concluded with Bible reading and devotion. So, these young people are not just empowered with football skills, but they are given a solid Bible foundation there would not get anywhere as most of them come from families that do not attend gospel preaching churches.

Coach Walter is actually not just a regular coach, but a Pastor, a missionary, an evangelist, and a church planter who having attended the MC2 trainings went about and started implementing some of the things he learnt using all availing opportunities.

Speaking of his influence, Pastor Walter said " I was surprised one Sunday morning coming out of church when I met this young boy and he greeted me in delight saying 'hi coach', This actually showed me that reaching out to the young people through soccer had made them want to attend church too."

Pastor Walter started his sports ministry from a small group he had at Mbikwakhe. Since Mbikwakhe is a gang and crime inflicted area, he felt the need to reach the young people of the area.

He started the soccer ministry, and youth outreach programs whereby young teens, even girls this time, would meet play games, and have a bible study sessions.

God also opened doors for Pastor Walter to plant a church at Ka Ndinda in the Shiselweni region. He went about sharing the gospel in different homes of the area and met a lady who helped find a place where they could regular meet, and later the meetings turned in a church as more people flocked in.

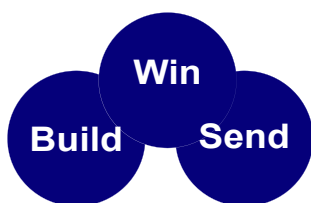
