WOMEN MINISTRY HOST SUCCESS AT SCHOOL TOT

Though scheduled to be a four day training from the 15th to 18th November, the training eventually commenced on the 16th because of a political unrest that occurred on 15 November 2022.

The workshop was attended mainly by educators as the majority of participants were teachers, lecturers, and school principals who vowed to implement much of what was learnt after the training, and also expressed their excitement about the contents of the educational materials.

This was a national training that brought participants from different parts of the country. Having sent invitations letters, the reception from the institution was very positive. Some of the institutions that agreed to partner with Campus Crusade for Christ Eswatini for this initiative include: Eswatini Medical Christian University (EMCU) which

> 31 participants graduated with the silver certificates, most of whom were educators. On 11th December 2022, 20 of the 31 participants returned for practical presentations of what was learnt in the workshop where they graduated with gold certificates.



ISRAEL STUDY TOUR Eswatini Report

On 29th October 2022, I left Eswatini to attend the CCCI & Herodium & Cru Leadership Jordan Ri Development Israel Study Qelt, Ten Tour, which lasted until 10th Bethseida November 2022.

The study tour was part of CCCI & Cru leadership development program which focuses on equipping leaders across all countries where Campus Crusade for Christ is active. The tour leaders included Bill Hodgson, Stephen Dell, Wade Mantlo and John Ellis among others.

From the first day, there was an orientation meeting that focused on *Jesus' model of making disciples*. This became the theme of the whole tour as leaders explored the geographical locations Jesus lived and visited throughout his ministry.

Some of the places that were toured include; Old city walls of Jerusalem, Israel Museum, Sepphoris,

Mount Olives, Herodium, Nativity Church, Jordan River, Qumran, Wadi Qelt, Temple Mount, Pool of Bethseida, The Western Wall, Mount Arbel, Nazareth Village, Dan, Peter Noster, Korazin, Capernaum, Mount Dan, Nof Ginnosar, Kursi, Caesarea Phillipi, Beth Shean, Decapolis, The Church of Primacy, Upper Room, Garden Tomb, Wohl Museum, Dominus Flevit Chapel, Caiphus House, Via Dolorosato, Church Sepulchre and the Southern Steps of the Temple Mount.

The Jesus Model of Making Disciples was evident and clearly explained as we toured the different places. Throughout the study, 5 phases were identified in Jesus' journey while building the movement of multiplying disciples.

These phases were:

- 1. The Preparation Period (birth, youth, baptism)
- Ministry Foundations (temptation, disciples)

- 3. Ministry Training (Call of the four)
- 4. Expanded Outreach (6 fishing-for-men, etc.)
- 5. Leadership Multiplication (where he appointed, and sent the 12 and 72, etc.)

When I arrived back in Eswatini, I was eager to share the newly found information and experience with the team, so we organized a training where all the CCC Eswatini staff partook.

We printed the framework process in A4 papers, distributed it to everyone and watched the video that detailed how Chritst built his movement. After watching the video, we had a deep discussion on how his ministry related to the 5 phases according to the framework.

We also identified our loopholes in our ministry in relation to how we currently Perform in relation to discipleship. We also identified the importance of having individual work for every staff in relation to sharing the gospel and building, training, sendina multiplying disciples.

We also highlighted the importance of beina intentional in the discipleship process and helped our new staff in identifying themselves more with CCC discipleship tools which was something they immensely were not engaged in as they are with evangelism tools strategies.

Once again, I would love to thank God and everyone that made my trip to Israel a success.
