This year, SLM has made it a priority to implement what was learnt in the MD Training to improve the stats in our Win-Build-Send mission. The team has been studying the MD Training modules and meeting with their small groups respectively and God has been so good.

God has been gracious to the ministry by opening doors in different institutions through the Study with Success program.

Some of the institutions where movements have started include Limkokwing University, Eswatini Medical Univeristy, and few high schools. The SLM team has mostly been engaging disciples from these institutions this month. 6 small groups have been established.

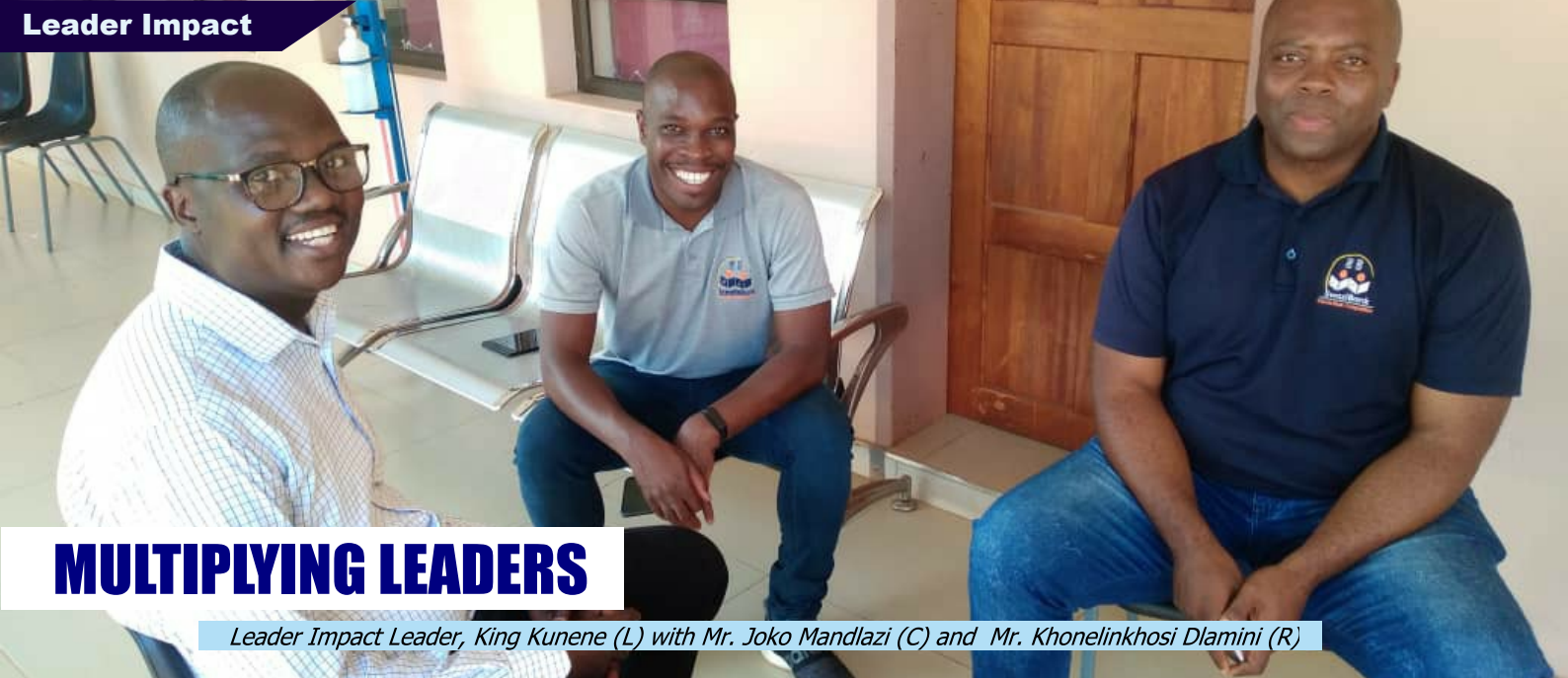

On 2nd February 2023, a Success at School seminar was held at St. Mary's High School by Campus Crusade for Christ. This was another follow up from the Success at School training of trainers workshop.

Sihle Nxumalo, who is a teacher at St. Mary's High was the one who attended the Training of trainers and later convinced the principal to host the seminar for the learners which lasted the whole school day.

All learners attended the seminar including all classes from Form 1 to Form 5, alongside their class teachers who were there to guide the learners as they learnt in the seminar.

Campus Crusade for Christ Eswatini travelled to St Mary's with Rev. Samson Nzima, Mrs Ncamsile Nzima, Sibusiso Mlambo, Ps King Kunene, Mancoba Dlamini, Luvuyo Dube, Mnotfo Nkambule, Thandi Shabangu, Vusa Sithole, and partners that included Nomsa Dlamini, and Similo Dlamini.



The topics that were covered included; *Setting Priorities, Setting Goals, Keeping Yourself Sharp, Preparing for Exams, Daily Performance Curve, Taking Notes, Memory Strategies, Being Proactive,* and *Reading Techniques.*

A total of 116 students received Christ at St Mary's High School from the seminar.

The school's principal Mr. Sithembiso Dlamini expressed his excitement with the seminar citing that he had just heard about the training from Sihle and did not know the content of the workshop were so relevant to the empowerment of the learners.

"If I had known that the workshop she attended was of this magnitude; I would have sent even more teachers to attend the workshop." He said.

Miss Nelisiwe Mkhonta, one of the teachers at the school also expressed her delight with the content of the training saying she feels like it was not just applicable to the students but also to parents as well.

"I have learnt a lot at personal level today, I think I will implement most of what I have learnt with my children at home, and desire that there be a training for parents also in the future' she said.

The learners were also excited and cooperative throughout the seminar.

Women Ministry leader, Mrs. Ncamsile Nzima also expressed her delight with the seminar citing that it is encouraging to see the overwhelming reception that the SAS seminars have been receiving.

"The most important thing is seeing the change after the seminars, so is encouraging to see the learners paying close attention and cooperation to what is being taught. It gives us the hope that they're learning a lot." She said.

The online training has an impressive attendance as over 200 participants registered to be part of the training. The training is held using Zoom, and is facilitated by GCM members.

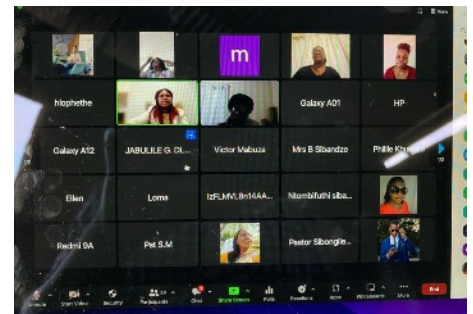

GOD CAUSES GROWTH

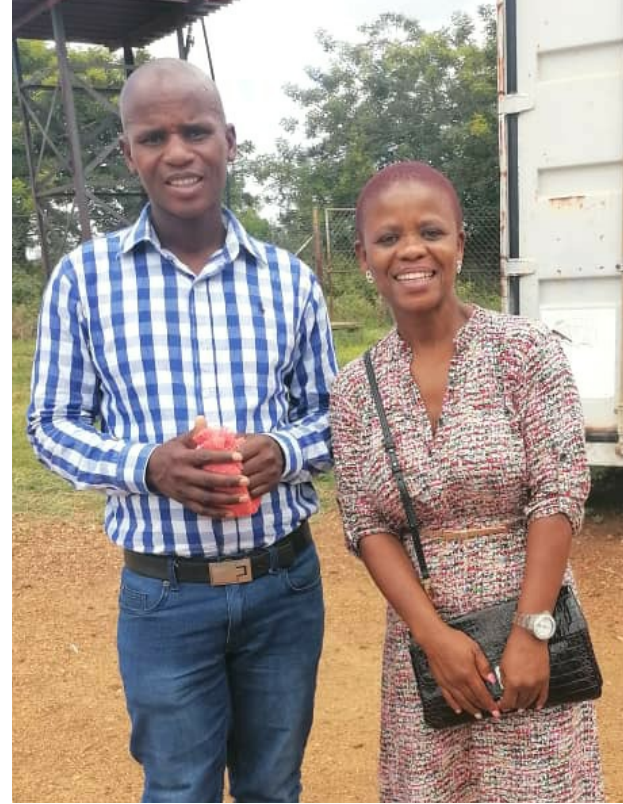
In 1 Corinthians 3:6 Paul writes that he sowed a seed and Apollos watered, but it was God that made it to grow.

On the 15th February 2023, I was privileged to leave Eswatini for Kigali in Rwanda attending a Fundamentals of Accounting training that lasted until 22 February 2023.

I am more than grateful for the opportunity to represent the local ministry in the training, and I was delighted to vitally network with other accountants from the other countries. Another beautiful thing to note is the kind gesture of the Rwandan people and their beautiful and their utopian country.

We were reminded about the vision and mission of the ministry, and also about the significance of our presence which is to increase capacity.

The lead facilitators included Tomas Chvojka, from Global Finance, and Clemence Fomevor from Ghana.

We learnt about maximizing our usage of the different accounts we have, and on managing responsibility centres effectively. We took a deep dive into the CCC tools including Google Suite, Ms Excel, & Netsuite. We also given an examination on the things we learnt the results which we received when we've returned.

We also covered recording transactions using Netsuite, such as income, deposits, and payment processes in the system.

Overall, the training came at a right time for us as a local ministry, at the beginning of the year and aligning with our year plan to maximize our system usage.

Already, we have already started on implementing most of the things we were learning and I believe that this training will yield astounding results.
