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# Global OpsFC *visit* ESWATINI

Between January 28th to 31st, Eswatini was blessed with the visitation of a Global Ops team that included; Jon Vellacott, Saki Ahiza, and Eunice Mekwi.

They were able to have different meetings with the leadership team, operations team, and all staff in their stay in the country. The purpose of the trip was to encourage the local ministry to use ministry systems effectively and to help maximize building capacity for the operations team.

Jon who is the IT Global Director made it clear that technology can unlock phenomenal growth in connecting needs with trustworthy solutions. So it will be wise to build capacity and wait for the growth that God will bring rather than see growth and don't have the right capacity to sustain that growth.

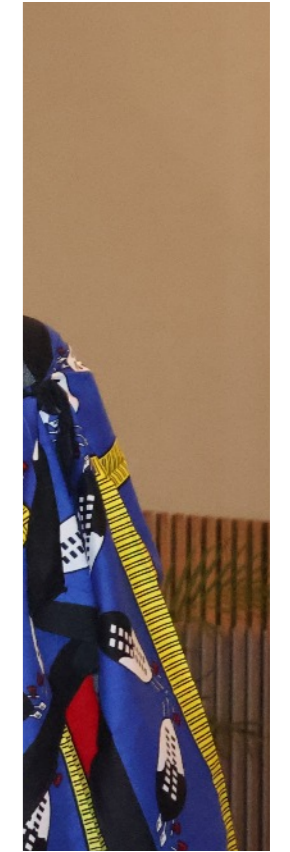
"More jars equates more oil, and few jars equates few oil." He said. Governments build roads and wait for cities to develop into those areas and not otherwise. Operations in each national ministry are building roads through (NetSuite, Power BI, MPDX etc) for field ministries to flourish.

The local ops team was reminded that even though results can be attained without these systems we cannot maximize the results without them. So there is an urgent need to leverage them in a greater capacity that can help sustain the organization's functionality.

These tools help in minimizing time and resources consumption, maximize productivity and help in accountability controls. With systems like Netsuite, staff can now sit request and receive their funds at the comfort of their seats at home.

Jon mentioned that the Global security team blocks at least 8000 malicious attacks and threats to our systems daily. That is why he is encouraging the usage of our work email addresses. Personal addresses are not protected

The Eswatini OpsFC team was not left out on the blessing of a new laptop. The NTL expressed his gratitude for this great gesture and practicality of not only equipping his Ops team in training but with tools for the work.



On the last the team alongside ops staff visited the national museum, Mantenga Cultural village and later had a dinner at Hilton Gardens Inn. The Eswatini leadership gave *emahiya* to the leaders as a token of appreciation for the visit.

After the visit, the ministry completely switched to full time Netsuite usage. We are still working on formulating financial policy, and have started developing the national ministry website which is linked and hosted with official Cru websites globally.

We are more than grateful for the visit which has equipped the ministry to this magnitude. We are trusting God for more effectiveness and excellence in using the systems that will make our work much convenient.



# HAVING A HEART FOR MISSIONS



The year began on a high note as we received 12 missionaries from Korea Campus Crusade for Christ who were here for a short missionary trip that lasted 14 days in the country.

The group included 1 staff and 11 students. The unfortunate part was that they came at a time when only a few tertiary institutions were open. They were able nonetheless to join local SLM in visiting *Limkokwing University of Creative Technology (LUCT)* & *Eswatini Medical Christian University (EMCU)*.

In their stay, we were able to host a memorable city wise meeting for potential multiplying disciples from the 2 universities. The city wise meeting took place at the prestigious campus crusade conference. This event marked the culmination of days of hard work,

vigorous evangelism, and discipleship that the SLM staff and Korean team led lasting for about two weeks.

Walking into the venue, you would sense an atmosphere of bliss, unity and true worship as students from the different universities mingled with Korean team. The venue was ignited with energetic and dedicated young people who are ready to share the gospel of Jesus Christ everywhere they go. In total, 32 students were present.

The city wise meeting commenced with powerful testimonies from students were expressing their love of God and their sincere gratitude to the Korean missionaries for reaching out to them with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

SLM leader, Mancoba also shared a

a sermon that empowered the students to begin sharing the gospel in their universities, to ensure that the gospel is spread everywhere they are so that the great commission of Jesus Christ is achieved. This sermon was based on Mathew 28; 18-20.

After the departure of the Korean team, SLM staff has continued with discipleship in the different universities. Limkokwing University has been meeting mainly online, while EMCU meet on Mondays, and ECOT meet every Tuesday.

We are also preparing for a New Life Training Course (NLTC) and a Multiplying Disciples (MD) training for the PMDs which will be held at CCC premises.

Since the beginning of the year, SLM has been able to expose the gospel to 512 people, 147 of whom prayed to receive Jesus. There has been follow up sessions to 22 individuals in the process.

## SWS AT MBABANE CAMPUS



The Study with Success program has opened doors for ministry across the country. It is a very effective academic excellence program that has been adopted in over 30 countries worldwide. In Eswatini, it has been adopted by most if not all the major universities. This include, EMCU, LUCT, SANU, and most recently, UNESWA.

The SLM team has been able to form a partnership with UNESWA's Mbabane Campus whereby they continuously visit the students from time to time to equip them with the Study with Success topics, and techniques.

The team visited the campus in January 2024 to yet again equip the students. The topics that were covered include; Setting Priorities, SAFE Principle to use in class, Personal Sleep Needs, and Keeping Yourself Sharp.

At least 7 out of 100 students that attended prayed the prayer to receive Christ. The SLM team has been helping with discipleship with the new converts.

The faithfulness of God is evident everyday as we see the Holy Spirit taking charge and changing lives.



## MC2 TOT AT THOKOZA

Looking at how the church grew and multiplied during the era of Paul, we see a good model on how the church should grow and multiply today.

God used Paul to make multiplying disciples so much that the gospel was able to spread in the whole region of Asia (Now Europe). How can we accelerate the spread of the gospel in Eswatini? The answer is through multiplying disciples and multiplying churches.

To raise multiplying disciples, we need to target existing believers who are faithful, available and teachable. We need to invest on training them to become multiplying disciples and build movements of multiplying churches.

MC2 training process is one of the catalyst that could drive to church multiplication movements.

GCM identified 20 MC2 practitioners and trained them on the upgraded 3.1 MC2 version. Through this training we want to raise a team of Trainers who will be master trainers within the four regions of Eswatini. The training was held between 22nd and 24th February to 2024 at Thokoza Conference Centre in Mbabane.

The aim of the TOT was to make the participants familiar with MC2 Launch booklet topics, have simulation, and be able to train others. The trainees were really impressive in their simulation proving that they were well equipped.



Trainees were grouped into three groups for follow-up and coaching. The team is looking forward to see each participant organizing at-least one training and training from 10 participants to 20 on the launch training and launching them to be seed sowers and start movements.

The GCM staff was divided to be coaches for each group and trainees were encouraged to support each other by attending and facilitating if anyone in their group hosted a training.

Just as Jesus knew that His ministry would not be effective if He worked alone but wisely selected, trained and sent His disciple to share the gospel and make more disciples; GCM eswatini is on the same mission this year, as we are totally devoted to seeing multiplying disciples everywhere until everyone knows someone who truly follow Christ.

We pray that the Father of the harvest would send more labourers who will be faithful to the mission of Jesus, Amen.

## MBABANE CHECKERS TOT

On the 17th February, GCM went to Jesus Restores Centre in Checkers to train trainers, who were part of the training that was on the 26th January 2024, on how to be trainers of MC2.

47 people attended the training and they started learning from Friday at 1700hrs to 2000hrs and then on Saturday learnt from 1000hrs to 1400hrs and they did the MC2 overview, learnt “the mission of Jesus, the amazing question, keeping in step with the Holy Spirit and also learnt God-Prepared people”.

The Jesus Restores Centre team is looking forward towards using the trained team in training other believers on the launch training of MC2.

## SIHHOYE EVANGELISM

On January 13th, Mnotfo Nkambule and Thandukwazi Makhathini (GCM staff and volunteer), visited Sihhoye Church of God of prophecy where they trained the church on evangelism using three MC2 topics; *The Amazing Question*, *Sharing Your Personal Story*, and *Sharing The Gospel Personally*.

After the training an outreach was made where 28 people were reached from 12 homesteads, 11 of whom prayed the prayer to receive Jesus Christ. One participant stated that he had left his brother who had many questions about the gospel, which he could not answer, but after the training, he said that he had all the courage to face him and lead him to Christ.

# UNESWA TOT

As a result, a Success at School Training of Trainers (TOT) was held at Kwaluseni Campus from 19 to 21 February 2024.

UNESWA selected student leaders from the 3 different campuses. The students are also in different years of their study and have been entrusted with the mandate to train others on using the Success at School techniques.

A total of 34 students and 4 lecturers attended and graduated with silver certificates after the training. Among those present in the training as university representatives included Mr. B. Kunene, Mrs S. Dlamini, Mrs N. Mabuza and Mr. B. Matse.

The topics that were covered include; *Setting Priorities, Setting Goals, Daily Performance Curve, Exam Perpetration, Setting Goals, Learning Styles, Personal Sleep Needs, and The Pareto Principle.*

The Campus Crusade for Christ team included National Director, Mr. Samson Nzima, Ncamsile Nzima (WM leader), the WM team, CCC staff, and CCC volunteers that included Mr. A. Amu who facilitated the topic of *Exam Preparation*

At least 4 students gave their lives to Christ after watching the *Falling Plates* video clip. These students will receive discipleship sessions from the Women’s Ministry team members.

One of the students that attended the training, Nosipho Shongwe highlighted how she felt impacted so much that she felt the need to reshuffle her study techniques wholly.

“I sincerely feel revived by this training, returning back, I will have to reshuffle everything. I will have to sit down and implement everything here in.” she said

The training came at the right time as the students were preparing to write examinations. Mr. Babili Kunene noted that training student leaders in the different campuses would help spread this techniques to more students.

“We chose student leaders from the different campuses to expedite the use of these techniques which we believe will help our students.” He said.

We thank God for partnership and pray for amazing results in the students lives.



## SAS AT MALKERNS VALLEY SCHOOL

On 16 February 2024 the WM team visited Marlkers Valley Primary School for a Success at School seminar.

The school was hosting the seminar for the second time as it hosted its first seminar in October 2023.

This time, the training was given to all the learners as they were divided into 3 groups, Grade 1-3, Grade 4-5, and Grade 6-7.

The CCC team that went to the school included; Rev. Samson Nzima (CCC

National Director), Ncamsile Nzima (WM leader), Vuyiswa Dlamini, Nomisa Dlamini, Ps. Sunshine, Gugu Shongwe, Dudu Shiba, Luvuyo Dube, Similo Dlamini and Vusa Sithole.

# RAISING LEADERS

Leader Impact in collaboration with SLM has been busy reaching students and parents with Study with Success and Success at School seminars.

The first for the year 2024 was at St. Holy Rosary High School in Mankayane, where we trained 91 students. After a few days we had to return for another seminar which had parents. 88 parents attended the seminar, 9 of whom prayed to receive Christ.

The second school was Nyetane High in Siteki where 410 students were trained, 56 of whom prayed to receive Christ. The last school was Lasi High where we trained over 400 students, with 370 of them praying to receive Jesus Christ.

Mrs. Precious Shongwe, who is a parent at St. Holy Rosary High who works as a secretary at hospital has started sharing her faith with the patients. Through our follow ups sessions, she learnt that she can also reach out to her colleagues, who are also professionals, through trainings.

This was really great news to her, as someone who is very passionate about winning her colleagues to Christ. She engaged relevant people regarding the possibility of a training on Evangelism, Discipleship and Multiplication for her colleagues from all the departments which was approved.

We are currently preparing for the training and we thank God looking at how He open doors and connect us with different people to the fulfilment of His mission.



# ALLOWING everyone to see and hear JESUS CHRIST



Our Jesus Film (JF) is still committed to multiplying new Christian believers and bringing the visuals of the gospel in communities and villages. As of February 2024, we shared the gospel to 80 people using Jesus Film. 30 people received Jesus Christ as Lord and savior.

We were also able to do discipleship at least one new believer, Mr. Manana using the *Walking with Jesus* episodes. He invited a group of 6 boys for our meeting which was scheduled for 5 Fridays. It was helpful to them. The now understand their salvation way better and have been challenged to also share the gospel.
