REACHING MORE WITH MORE

SLM plays a huge role in bringing more staff to the organization as a whole from their internship programs, and also from the mere fact that they work with students thus making it easier to identify those who have the passion for ministry.

With a shortage of staff from last year, we thank God that we were able to add at least five interns to the team which makes the SLM staff 8 now.

Morning Dew

With the grace of God we have maintained a partnership with Eswatini Medical Christian University. Here we use different techniques such as *Walking with Jesus*, *College Ready*, and *Morning Dew curriculum series*

After watching each clips, we discuss with students on how particular challenges encountered can be managed.



Students are also advised in a holistic approach. It is so heartwarming to see young people who dedicate their time for God, more topics such as dating right, empowering friendships, academic excellence and more topics are discussed. The importance of having an intimate relationship with God is also discussed with students so that they can be able to have access with the things God prepared for them.



STUDY WITH SUCCESS SEMINARS

SLM has been actively visiting schools to have Study with Success seminars. Study with Success is a program that helps students and learners with study techniques that propels academic excellence.

The team has been able to have seminars at Sigangeni Primary School, Sigangeni High School, Motshane High, Lidwala High School, New Life Academy and Mbabane Central High School.

Through these seminars, the gospel was presented to 1,415 students. 292 students prayed to receive Christ in the process.

The SLM team which facilitated in these seminars included staff members, interns, student leaders and key volunteers. Some of the seminars were in partnership with Leader Impact whereby the teachers received a Success At School seminar session from Leader Impact.

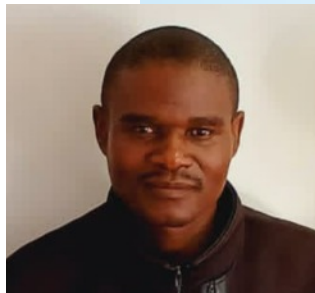

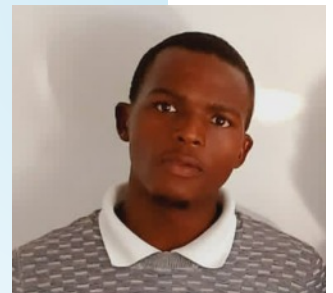

BOLDLY MULTIPLY

A GCM CHURCH PLANTING CAMPAIGN
- MAY 2024



OUTREACH AT MTIMANE AEC

May is always the month of harvest for GCM and that is when they maximize their God-given strengths to go out and reach the nation through a church planting campaign. GCM ESwatini also took part in the church planting campaign for 2024 which had a theme “Boldly Multiply” and the goal was to raise 50 churches to become multiplying churches to the 4th generation. GCM created awareness on evangelism, discipleship and church planting, train 1000 believers on MC2.

God loves men and has a wonderful plan for their lives; it is the intent of Campus Crusade for Christ that churches should pioneer into mission gaps and that means reaching the areas that are not easily and commonly reached. Africa Evangelical Church at Mtimane in Mankayane invited GCM on the 4th May 2024 where there was a partnership with Pastor Mngometulu of Malanti, with his 8 church members where Mnotfo did a vision casting to the new members from Malanti and then proceeded to teaching the participants on how to share the 4 spiritual laws where upon finishing, there was an outreach to the

areas of KaVelezizweni, Luhlendlweni and Mtfongwaneni.

Ten teams of three people each went to share the gospel after learning and practicing in class which started at 10am to 11am and then went sharing the 4 spiritual laws to the community up to 3pm and came with amazing results. The participants were so amused to use such an easy tool to evangelize and they mentioned that they were even able to share to a traditional healer, drunkards and smokers, some wanted to ask many questions, but the booklet would just answer the questions leaving them speechless; isn't God not GOOD!

140 people were reached and 24 people gave their lives to Jesus Christ and the church gathered the records of homesteads reached, and cell-phone numbers so that they do follow-up. The Malanti brethren were so interested in learning MC2 so that they also know more skills for the great commission and they said that they will also host an outreach and invite GCM to train them on evangelism as a church at large.

MC2 TRAINING AT NHLANGANO FREE GOSPEL CHURCH

GCM went to train 18 branches of Free Gospel Church in Nhlango on the where pastors and church leaders were trained on MC2 from Friday evening, 10 May 2024 to Saturday, 11 May 2024 at 2pm where they trained the leaders all the MC2 topics and commissioned them to go and share the gospel and start discipleship groups. Mnotfo, Nosimilo, Nelisiwe and Sibusiso facilitated the training with Mr Ndabezitha of SU organized the training as the secretary of Free gospel church. The participants were divided into 3 groups and Mnotfo, Nosimilo and Nelisiwe were tasked to be the coaches.



MC2 TRAINING AT LUHLOKOHLA HIS MERCY INTERNATIONAL CHURCH

His Mercy International church was also mesmerized to learn from GCM after they heard the team on VOC and they invited them on the 19th May 2024 to train the church on MC2 where 50 church members were part of the training and Mnotfo and Sibusiso were the facilitators and did an introduction, the mission of Jesus and the amazing question. The church was then assigned to go and share the amazing question to 5 people each so that in the next meeting they share how they went sharing it and then will go on to learn how to lead someone to Christ.





MC2 TRAINING AT KA BOYCE

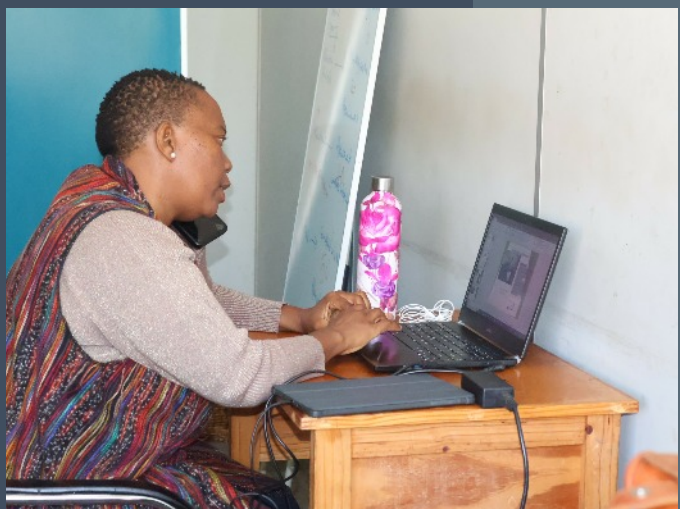
The last training done in May was done on the 26th May 2024 at AEC at kaBoyce where Mnotfo and Nosimilo went to introduce MC2 to the church and they did the mission of Jesus, the amazing question and sharing your personal story. The church received the training with enthusiasm and they were so interested to go and share the gospel. About 150 church members were trained and commissioned.

All these trainings done in May added up in the objective of the campaign, which was training 1000 believers on MC2, creating awareness on evangelism, discipleship and church planting and targeting existing churches to be multiplying churches.

As missionaries dedicate their time and effort in doing ministry, there is a vital need for partners who will support the work.

This June, the GCM team has been involved mainly in Ministry Partner Development (MPD) which allows anyone to become a financial partner for the different missionaries. It extends the opportunity to those who might want to do missions but are occupied elsewhere to partner with the field missionaries financially.

THEY ALREADY HAVE AN IDEA

In this issue, Vusa Sithole (CCC media officer) had an interview with GCM staff Mnotfo Nkambule to discuss the BOLDLY MULTIPLY campaign and the zeal for ministry. The interview went like this...

VS: Msutfu, thank you so much for doing the interview in the busy GCM schedule.

MN: My pleasure Mr Sithole. I'm also excited to share with you about our ministry.

VS: Indeed, we've noticed that you are consistently visiting different churches on Sundays. Can you elaborate more on that ?

MN: So the team (GCM) is invited to train members on the program MC2 so that they all know how to do evangelism and discipleship. It was our objective during the campaign to train at least 1000 believers on MC2. Therefore, we are seeing a great success of our campaign.

VS: Oh nice, so you are specifically visiting different churches. Is it MC2 or Vision Casting or both?

For those churches who never met us before, we begin from doing vision casting and then proceed to train the church on Mc2. The mass media made it easier for us to be known, so when we go to the churches, we find them already having an idea of what we do.

VS: That is really interesting. So going to VOC in the May campaign did play a huge role in that?

MN: Indeed. It was where we made people aware of who we are, what we do and how they can meet us and work with us. We created the passion in people’s hearts of willing to partake in the great commission and to plant churches.

VS: Wow, that is really impressive. Speaking of the campaign, How was the BOLDY MULTIPLY message received? looking back, would you say you achieved your goals with the campaign?

MN: Through the Boldly Multiply campaign, we wanted to create awareness on evangelism, discipleship and church planting, train 1000 believers on MC2 and to make existing churches to be multiplying churches. We therefore had leaders calling us to go and visit their churches because they were mesmerised by our goals and they wanted to be part of those whom we targeted to reach and develop in the great commission.

VS: Oh nice,

MN: One preacher from Lavumisa even called and asked for an online training because he felt like it was not possible that we come to his church to train the entire church since his pastor did not listen to the program. This shows that anyone who heard us speaking was challenged in his heart to start doing something concerning the great commission.

VS: Wow, that is really interesting and we thank God for that.

MN: Indeed. God is good.

VS: So how are you balancing between being available for your own church and working every weekend?

MN: We encourage churches to invite us on Saturdays instead of Sundays, so those churches that invite us on Sundays do it on our first time together so that we make the entire church aware of what we will be training the church and they partake in the first training session for MC2 then they want more, so when we come for the second session on Saturday, they already are waiting for it with enthusiasm.

VS: Oh that is really interesting. Now, as a young person yourself who is devoted in doing ministry, how important it is to practice what you preach and how do you stay in check?

MN: Everything works best in its time and it is now the time of the Holy Spirit; is is He who works in us to make us good tools for His work. He shapes our character to live like Christ and therefore i am able to live my message.

VS: That is interesting Nceku. Thank you so much for being faithful, zealous and accountable in your work. We hope that you will inspire other young people to share the gospel everywhere they are.

MN: Indeed, by the grace of God, li believe that we will have more fishers of men.

VS: Thank you so much Msutfu for your time. May God bless you as you go around doing ministry

WOMEN INITIATIVE IN ESW

Eswatini Women Ministry leader Ncamsile Nzima attended the Women Initiative Conference that was held from 11 to 15 March 2024 in Ethiopia. Over 80 women leaders from 50 countries attended, and they were encouraged to start movements in their respective countries.

Eswatini therefore organized its Women Initiative Training of Trainers (TOT) from 7 to 9 May 2024. The training was held at Campus Crusade for Christ hall. At least 55 participants that attended, coming from the four different regions in the country and all walks of life.

The participants were trained mainly on how to use the Jesus Film app to

conveniently share the gospel, start small groups and do discipleship. The whole training of trainers was facilitated by Mike and Natasha Lotter from Campus Crusade South Africa.

All participants were required to download the Jesus Film App and were oriented on how to use it, and other materials like the Reflections of Hope and Knowing Jesus.

The emphasis on using the Jesus Film app did not only empower women to The emphasis on using the Jesus Film app did not only empower women to continually share the gospel, but it beckoned them into being digital missionaries.



SWATINI TO IMPROVE LIVES

The Eswatini National director highlighted on the importance of this feat by encouraging the participants to declare that they are digital missionaries.

This initiative will go a long in equipping women to become disciple-makers by providing them with the needed resources and opportunities. The goal is to raise 1,000 women leaders by December 2025 in Eswatini which will add up to the 100,000 women leaders target for the Women Initiative Project as a whole.

To achieve this feat, the local team assigned each other to mobilize and organize different women leaders and movements according to

the four regions in the country; Hhohho, Manzini, Lubombo and Shiselweni.

The training of trainers was not just an event but an ignition of the needed zeal to spread the good news of our Lord everywhere.

As a result of the training, we have been able to reach 420 people with the gospel. 146 people prayed the prayer to receive Christ and 14 small groups were started.

This is only the beginning as we are trusting God for more knowing the initiative will reach to many women around the country who will also carry the mission. We sincerely believe that Eswatini will never be the same.

The Women Initiative has come to give women an empowering platform to share the gospel, start small groups and even plant churches. The Jesus Film App is its tool that helps with content accessibility, efficiency and organized engagements, to bear the desired Godly fruits.



IMPLEMENTATION **SMALL GROUPS**

After the Women Initiative TOT, there has been movements everywhere as participants started implementing what they learnt. The emphasis was on using the Jesus Film app to start conversations, connect with other people, share the gospel, and start discipleship groups.

Most participants started using the app in their family devotion times. Some introduced it to their churches, schools, campuses, and workplaces. With so much content in the app which covers different topics and approaches, it is significantly easy to engage with different people from different backgrounds.

Pastor Mandla Maziya introduced the Jesus film app segments to the youth of his church. Every Sunday after church, the youth remain behind to watch a few segments. He attested that the number of youths who attended the church has since increased.

Tenetile Dlodlu also got to integrate the Jesus Film app during launch hour fellowships. Pastor Khulekani Tsabedze introduced the app to the church's Sunday school which increased the number of children who attend church now.

It is encouraging to see the vigorous dedication the participants are showing in implementing what was taught from the Jesus Film App TOT.



SUCCESS AT SCHOOL SEMINARS

The Women Ministry is still committed to empowering students and learners with study techniques for academic excellence using the Success At School program.

Having hosted the Success at School Training of Trainers (TOT) at UNESWA early this year, the team has been working with some of the trained students as they go around the country empowering other students.

IDE First year students at UNESWA had the chance to get trained on Success at School as the team visited Kwaluseni Campus on Tuesday 25 June 2024, and Thursday 27 June 2024. The plan is to make frequent seminars on SAS at the campus and equip as many students as there can be.

Some of the students that have been able to facilitate in SAS seminars yet include, Bandile Mphila, Mzwakhe Mabuza, Nosipho Shongwe, and Aline Iradikunda.

Schools are not an exception as the team visits different schools for the seminars. All Saints Primary had its seminar on 21st June 2024. Teacher Tjengisile Ziyane, who is also part of Women Ministry, regularly meet with the learners every Firday to equip them with life skills.

The team also had the chance to facilitate at Mpaka High School in the Lubombo region. The seminar was given to Form 5s and Form 3s who are actually getting ready for external exams. 75 learners prayed to receive Christ at Mpaka High.

The team was also warmly welcomed at SAIM Christian High school where they had a seminar for Form 5s on July 3rd 2024. At least 15 learners prayed the prayer to receive Christ. Siphocosini High was the next stop after SAIM where the whole school was presented with SAS topics. At least 58 learners raised their hands to received Christ there.

Aline Iradukunda is a student at Univeristy of Ewatini who among some fellow colleagues was selected to attend the Women Initiative training of trainers at Campus Crusade for Christ premises.

She was in Mozambique when she got the invitation, and even contemplated declining. But, she felt like there was more that she would learn from the training and begged her parents to allow her to travel back to Eswatini just for the training.

She was excited to meet other participants and to learn about the Jesus Film app which is very convenient when sharing the gospel, leading small groups and discipleship.

Aline had identified herself as someone who is not a social media person, when she was

asked about her plans in sharing the gospel using those platforms. However, she took a photo from one of the presentations which read, "God, do you really care about me?" and posted it on her Whatsapp status. One of her contacts texted her lamenting how she felt as if God was far off. Aline then engaged in a constructive conversation with her contact which was not going to be possible if she did not share the conversation starter.

"This honestly opened my eyes to know that I have to be intentional when I post on the social media platforms as many people benefit even if they do not say." She said.

Aline's story is one in many that happen when believers decide to use their social media spaces to start God centred conversations.

Another scintillating story is that of Happy Simelane, a student from UNESWA who was part of the Women Initiative TOT.

She had always wanted to share her faith ever since she came to know Christ. With all the zeal and passion she had, she still needed some discipleship, evangelism tools and resources to be equipped herself. So, she was very happy to meet Campus Crusade for Christ.

“Meeting Campus really helped in boosting the courage to share. I had always had this passion, so learning about the tools like the Jesus Film app really made a difference to me.” She said.

As a testament to her words, she was one of the participants that were quick to start using the Jesus Film App after the training. Her first group included family and friends from where she was based.

“After the training, I got busy somewhere and I shared the segments using the app with different people there. Giving them the opportunity to watch the Jesus film in the segments enabled us to start conversing about God.” She narrated.

Happy had relocated to another community as her university was closed. It was in this community where she started sharing and had evening meeting where they watched the segments and had discussions.

“When I returned home, I did not stop, With God’s grace I was also able to meet with the local savings cooperation members and shared a few segments.”

Seeing the response and impact sharing is Happy was quick to write and encourage other participants by saying;

“I saw firsthand the power of the Word of God to transform lives. The women in this group were deeply engaged and receptive to the message of Jesus’ love and salvation. It was a powerful reminder of the importance of sharing the Gospel with those who may not have had the opportunity to hear it before.

I encourage each and every one of you to consider reaching out to women in your own communities and sharing the message of Jesus with them. By doing so, you have the potential to change lives and make a real difference in the world.”



EQUIPMENT ASSISTANCE

Since we currently do not have equipment, we were assisted by Jesus Film Project South Africa which provided 2 projectors, Jesus film outdoor screen, power generator, and a horn speaker. We genuinely appreciate the kind gesture.

PRAYER

The Women Initiative Eswatini also believes in the power of prayer as we do ministry. We have an online prayer every Wednesdays at 04:00 AM to 05:00 AM. We also had two live prayer sessions yet which included 27 April 2024 and 30 May 2024.

When Mary learnt that God had chosen her to be one that will the baby Jesus, she had only a few words of submission saying “Hear I am, the Lord’s servant, May it happen to me as you have spoken.” (Luke 1:38)

This attitude of total surrender is what we have witnessed with the Women Ministry team in recent months. They sacrificed their time and resources to see the gospel reach every soul near within their reach. All driven by zeal to be available when God want someone to use.

Everyone is playing a significant role right where she can, even from using the Jesus Film app in family devotions or sharing the gospel in a bus using the FOUR spiritual laws or being there in the morning prayer calls. The desire to preach the good news everywhere is seen and felt within the team as God leads.

As wonderful and faithful as God is, He has led the team in different outreaches like the one at Moyeni Church of God of Prophecy in April, and another outreach at Fanteni Evangelical Church on 29 June 2024.

The team trains church members on how to use the Four Spiritual Laws as they share the gospel. They also walk with them as they share the gospel in the different homes. At Moyeni, God’s presence could not be doubted as a toddler who was believed to be mute since birth started muttering words after a prayer session in one homestead. She was heard saying “Jesus” to everyone’s amusement.

As some do evangelism outreaches others continue with hospital, prison and charity ministries distinctively. It has been amazing to hear of the great things that God does with these women that avail themselves saying; “Here I am LORD...”

Leader Impact has been able to host Success at School Teacher's seminars in different schools.

The first seminar was held at Lidwala High on the June 8th 2024. 10 teachers attended the seminar and received it with great excitement.

The feedback from the teachers was very encouraging. Some teachers praised the seminar saying it was very helpful and refreshing. They requested that we come yearly, and some committed themselves for engagements with CCC or Leader Impact in the future.

The next school was Sigangeni High where 18 teachers attended. This seminar was held on 19th June 2024. Again the teachers were delighted with this empowerment expressing their heartfelt gratitude and willingness to engage in small groups.

The most exciting news was to have 5 teachers pray to receive Jesus Christ! This is really inspiring knowing that teachers spend most of their time with students who are future leaders. One can foresee a blissful future when such decisions are made as the impact of Christ will be felt not just in their lives but even to the people they are leading.



We can always look back and thank God for the amazing work He is doing with us as we avail ourselves.

Another Success at School seminar for Teachers was held at Mbabane Central High school on 27th June 2024. Here, 3 teachers prayed to receive Christ and the feedback was also positive and encouraging and 11 indicated that they are interested in further engagements, coaching or small groups participation.

The teachers seminars in these schools that Leader Impact visited emphasized the importance and need of the gospel for everyone, even more for leaders in the workplace.

It also showed that the Success at School program is indeed beneficial even to professionals as it is beneficial to learners. Some of the topics that the teachers had included Best Parenting Styles, Homework Support, Setting Goals among others.

Ever since its inception, the journey has never stopped but has been evolving to the latest technologies, more language interpretations and other resourceful series that complement the Jesus Film.

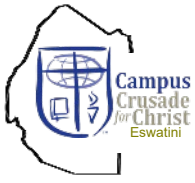
This include the Jesus Film app, which has segmented the Jesus film into 61 segments, and has other films like Walking with Jesus, Reflections of Hope, and other series of conversation starters.

The app does not however do away with outdoor shows especially in remote places

where it would be more convenient to reach a lot of people at a go. So, the JF team locally still visit those remote areas and share the gospel.

As of May 2024, the Jesus Film reached to over 400 people. 50 prayed to receive Jesus Christ as their Lord and saviour, and 6 members of the JF Eswatini team were trained on how to use the Jesus Film App.

These stats attest to the faithfulness of God and the undeniable fact that He will carry us all the way as we live to share the gospel until everyone knows Christ.

Being at the ADCS helped a lot as I got to learn how other digital missionaries are doing it in their respective countries.

With God's grace, I have been able to start a bible study group. We meet every night through a conference call.

Though we meet for Bible Study (OBBS), I also encourage and equip them to share their faith. This include orienting them on how to use the Four Spiritual Laws, sharing your testimony, amazing question and other ways like the Godstool, and Jesus Film app.

The journey has been more than amazing so far and I earnestly pray for sustainability.

DIGITAL OUTREACH WEEK (DOW)
